Dear Under Secretary Hale,

Thank you for your many years of diplomatic service on behalf of our country. Your efforts are certainly appreciated by many people.

I am writing to urge you in the strongest possible terms to pursue very powerful ontology based resources. These are programs that can make it possible for our government to resolve our country's most serious international challenges.

For example: Longstanding and recent challenges related to Russia, China, Iran, North Korea, the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, the Indian-Pakistani challenge, the issues related to Non-State actors, etc.

IMPORTANT: Before reading further it would save you possible misunderstanding to read the attached document called OIC-Delegating. This resource does not pass well through third parties. A serious direct discussion between you and I alone would preclude that problem. The programs are not similar to any other programs most are familiar with.

Challenges persist until the problem solvers are able to accurately identify the issues that would definitely lead to preventing or resolving their challenges. One of the key benefits of these short but powerful programs is that they dramatically expand the conscious awareness of the participants.

This will make it possible for foreign policymaker participants and others to accurately identify the critical issues continually bypassed. Problems like the decades long Israel-Palestinian conflict seem very difficult.

However, they would not seem so difficult to those who were crystal clear about what actions would definitely resolve that counter-productive and deadly entanglement. So far such clarity has been elusive to many well qualified officials. That would not be the case if the same officials or interlocutors had their conscious awareness dramatically expanded.

Globally, too many people have died, suffered and lost their human rights because so many serious challenges were not prevented or resolved. Additionally, as you know vast amounts of government revenue and the precious lives of our military heroes have been lost. My son was a US Marine Non-Commissioned Officer.

These resources have consistently produced outstanding results in whatever field where they were used worldwide since the 1970s. I would like to speak with you personally about this as soon as possible.
