Dear ,

These comments are related to our recent communications related to the urgent need for these extraordinary programs.

1-There are an overwhelming number of current and ongoing security and humanitarian challenges that our government and others are not solving after many years of hard work by exceptional officials. You know what they are and you know this is true. I am not discounting the successes of our officials but we both know they are nowhere close to what's needed.

2-No challenge can be mastered if the problem solver no matter how skilled or experienced they may be, does not have the level of conscious awareness required to identify what's missing in their policies, strategies and/or negotiations. This shortfall in conscious awareness that all human beings have is a major problem in foreign relations and in national security.

This has been a major source of a tremendous loss of life, great suffering and expanding global insecurity. We all know that the government has no real handle on how to get through to North Korea or Iran. All that seems to be done is waiting and proposing talks where there is no knowledge of how to get through to them diplomatically.

And, then there are the sanctions and pressure. How well would anyone you know respond to pressure, withholding needed aid, punishment or various types of widespread condemnation?

I am not into justifying the behavior of any adversary but it is just plain foolish to ignore misdeeds from the past, longstanding resentment, ineffective policies and communication that is so ineffective that it makes negotiations useless and possibility offensive. The eleven years of the 6 Party Talks and efforts with Iran have produced absolutely nothing useful while these governments have become more provocative.

Many thousands of Americans and others have died and suffered because foreign policymakers along with diplomats failed to identify what was needed to prevent or resolve our threats.

3-We are advocating the global use of widely proven ontology based high performance programs, that can remedy this shortfall in conscious awareness. They were developed specifically for clients to produce outstanding breakthrough results in all man-made challenges despite "perceived" obstacles.
