Major Breakthroughs through Ontology Based Programs

Ontology based programs and their transformational processes dramatically expand conscious awareness. This can make it possible for foreign policymakers and other officials to dramatically expand their problem solving capabilities far beyond what they currently believe to be possible.

There are critically important turning point issues continually bypassed when challenges go unresolved. These are issues that undermine the effectiveness of policies, negotiations and other challenges. Program participants attain the capability to accurately identify such issues making their efforts going forward highly effective.



Participation in the programs including the communication specific programs can make it possible to attain cooperation from the most difficult of adversaries.

Subsequently, officials would become able to effectively prevent or resolve conflicts, attain cooperation where needed as well as diminish hostility and resentment. This would also apply to preventing or resolving the abuse of human rights, human trafficking, genocide, refugees, etc.

Officials engaged in any aspect of counter-terrorism will be able to produce outstanding breakthrough results.

There will be breakthroughs beyond current successes in interdicting plots, intelligence gathering, cooperation between domestic and foreign government agencies and diminishing the ability of non-state actors to recruit new terrorists. New policies and strategies can be developed to reduce the desire or intentions of non-state actors to perpetrate terrorist attacks.

Throughout our research we networked with foreign relations officials and trainers within numerous governments. Not one single person in any government that we spoke to in 15 years ever heard of the program category of ontologically developed programs.

Yet, there are numerous corporations and organizations that have used the programs successfully for four decades worldwide! Program providers are not widely known to have seriously marketed to governments.

Obstacles to Program Clarity

1-Since officials are usually short on time and not aware of the existence of ontologically developed programs, many will automatically equate what they read with traditional programs they are familiar with.

Doing that which takes only a few seconds or minutes, officials erroneously assume that the purpose, execution and benefits are similar to the programs they have or know about. When they unknowingly misinterpret the nature of the programs, they dismiss their importance.

Note 1: There is absolutely no similarity whatsoever between ontology based programs and any program that a foreign relations official would be familiar with.

Ontology based programs are not offered at foreign service training institutes nor are they available within academia.

Note 2: Going back decades it has been long proven that ontology based programs cannot be assessed accurately through reading alone as one can with traditional programs.



The only way to attain the accurate clarity necessary for all program aspects is for an official to speak directly with a program expert.

The immediate feedback and other information given will clarify everything the official or prospective participant would need to know.

Without that discussion the official will only have blind assumptions.

2-Some officials have trouble accepting assertions of breakthrough results that contradict their views about what is or is not currently possible in foreign relations.

People also in the past thought speaking at long distances using a device was not possible. People thought it was a ridiculous idea that we could travel to the Moon. There are endless examples of new possibilities that people also thought at first were not possible.

The Differences between Ontology Based Programs and Standard Programs

1-Ontology based programs do not present formulas, methods, principles, techniques or philosophies to adopt and utilize. The purpose of ontology based programs are not to teach people “how to” solve problems.

They are not “how to do it” programs. Since experienced officials are already qualified to resolve challenges, they will produce breakthroughs once they recognize critical issues bypassed that have kept their challenges unresolved.

2-Although the information presented is fascinating, it is not presented to be memorized and used like in a typical college course. The information presented and discussed serve as processes that by the end of the program leaves participants expanding their conscious awareness related to the specific focus of the program involved.

Ex. Those participating in the communication programs for instance expand their conscious awareness in relationships of all kinds.

They start to recognize what needs to be addressed to create communication and relationship breakthroughs. This includes personal, family, work, community, project and international relations.
