Humanity is faced today with terrorists in numerous countries, terrorists seeking Weapons of Mass Destruction, tensions between nuclear armed states, numerous conflicts in the Middle East and in Africa, the abuse of human rights as well as trafficking in weapons, women and drugs.

The applicant must be someone who not only has a very serious concern about our global challenges, he or she must have a strong desire to work towards effective solutions now and not at some future date. The threats we all face and the suffering of millions are challenges happening right now.

We need several new intern-volunteers right away. Thus, applicants receiving this information must call us within 24 hours. In the event that anyone from OIC leaves a voice mail message or sends an e-mail to an applicant, we expect a response the same day. We only work with those who follow directions carefully.

While our interns learn certain valuable things working with us, applicants must clearly understand that our organization's mission is not to educate. OIC is not a university. We have no serious interest in helping one to forward their career.

Thus, the applicant's motivation in applying must be in total alignment with our mission to produce unprecedented breakthroughs in resolving global threats and human suffering.



Project Summary

The one thing common to all challenges unresolved is that the officials whose job it is to solve these challenges are clearly ineffective and not getting the job done. The consequences for their lack of effectiveness is costing the lives of millions, the suffering of millions and threatening the very survival of mankind.

It is not possible to effectively and completely resolve any serious international challenge if foreign policymakers and other officials are not clearly and accurately identifying what is missing in their efforts. The limitations on conscious awareness that all human beings are subject to are at the heart of the limited results produced by government officials to prevent or resolve mankind's greatest threats and the tragic suffering of millions.

We must realize that the survival of every man, woman and child on earth is every bit at risk from the current limited capabilities of government problem solvers as it is from brutal dictators, mindless governments and those using terrorism as a tool for their goals. Being a highly experienced, dedicated and well trained official does not make one aware enough to identify what is missing in their efforts to resolve serious challenges.

Most people do not recognize the fact that officials are barely scratching the surface of their capabilities.

Unknown to most in governments, in multilateral institutions, in think tanks and in academia, is the fact that for more than three decades, extensive research has produced extraordinary programs that dramatically expand human conscious awareness. This makes it possible to



produce major and totally unprecedented breakthroughs in all challenges. In the private sector when organization or corporate leaders and staff have used these resources, they have consistently produced breakthrough results.

The results were universally very, very far beyond their greatest expectations. The challenges involved long protracted labor strikes, violence, sabotage, other crimes, management issues, marketing troubles, very low productivity and low profitability.

In the case of foreign policymakers and negotiators choosing to use these programs, they will become aware of the fact that there is always more than one valid interpretation or assessment of the words and actions of adversaries. As long as officials remain stuck in counterproductive interpretations, their ability to communicate effectively and productively on the same page is not possible.

They will come to recognize the specific factors in their thinking; policies, communications and actions, past and present that undermine their effectiveness continually. They will become accountable for harm done and make serious amends. Old resentments will diminish.

Most of the international challenges thought to be so difficult will be resolved effectively through the global utilization of these programs.

The purpose of our interview

The purpose of our interview is for us to determine if the applicant is suitable for our mission. This means that the applicant has already enthusiastically decided to work with us and will agree to work with us in a professional manner.

This means that [a] they will follow directions carefully, [b] they will respond to calls and e-mails the same day, [c] they will keep their promises consistently and [d] they agree to join OIC as a dues paying member. OIC is totally supported by member dues for our organization's operating expenses.

Minimum annual membership dues are \$75.00. This can be paid in two or three payments IF absolutely necessary. Payments start on the applicant's start date.



Note: Being a member is not negotiable. Our dues are donations. They are taxable-deductible for US taxpayers. Since our dues are donations they are not refundable. Do not apply if you are unwilling to become a member or have any issue with this requirement.

Note: The purpose of the interview is also NOT to convince applicants to work with us. We have found that applicants who need convincing are not suitable for our position. Those who need convincing to be part of our ground breaking project to support breakthroughs in international relations should not apply.

This is an unpaid position. Since 1984 OIC has been a totally, home-based, all volunteer non-profit organization. Thus, no one in OIC is paid.

Our Highest Priorities

- Supporting unprecedented breakthroughs in eliminating the possession or pursuit of Weapons of Mass Destruction by non-state actors such as Al Qaeda, their affiliates and by current Non-WMD states such as Iran.
- Creating new and unprecedented levels of cooperation between nuclear armed states
- The prevention and resolution of armed conflicts and terrorism.
- Creating breakthroughs in reducing the abuse of human rights and trafficking in people and weapons.

Currently in this project started last year there are many high ranking officials in various governments and in multilateral institutions now such as the UN exploring the use of these breakthrough services with us.

We have been assisted in our advocacy by famous negotiators Senator George Mitchell the Former US Envoy for Middle East Peace and Former UN Under-Secretary-General Giandomenico Picco, a super star UN negotiator from the 1980s and 90s and others.



Intern-Volunteer Tasks

1-Special Assistants make calls to government and multilateral institution officials to explain our work in very basic terms to see if they are willing to discuss it in more depth with the Project Coordinator and then with the program experts.

Special Assistants also meet with officials depending on their location and our current needs.

2-Special Assistants also pursue discussions with members of other NGOs focused on global issues to develop their interest in our work. This is also a critical task because we need their advice, contacts and other forms of support such as financial support.

3-Special Assistants capable of developing social media may work on our three Social Media platforms.

4-Special Assistants post our volunteer positions on university job-sites.

5-Special Assistants also do various types of research related to our project.

Every volunteer team member must work a minimum of 5 flexible hours per week. The hours can be days, nights and/or weekends.

There are no limits to the number of hours one can work. There are also no limits on how long one can work with us.

All volunteers work from their home offices. There is no commuting to an office involved.

OIC has been an all volunteer, home based and non-profit organization since 1984.

We do not send anyone to other cities or other locations. We do not pay for any volunteer expenses. However, there rarely are any expenses.
